Kenya-Collaborative Behaviours

Enhance government leadership of sector planning processes

Strengthen and use country systems

Use one information and mutual accountability platform

Build sustainable water and sanitation sector financing strategies

1. Government is leading the sanitation sector/ coordination's (MOH), Water (MOW/s), School san. (MOE), Health facilities san.(MOH)
2. Progressively planning together with partners utilising government planning circles (MTPs, CIDPs, MTEF)
3. Water sector Joint Review. We are yet to integrate and strengthen sanitation Joint reviews. Country uses quarterly forums to assess progress
4. Expenditure budgets easily available from government. WASH TrackFin Report available.
5. Counties progressively developing investment plans



Putting Collaborative behaviors into Practice

- ◆ Country action plan after Addis Ababa Meeting (2016)
- ◆ High Level advocacy in all 47 Counties-Council of governors forums
- ◆ Supporting the inclusion of CBs in County Integrated Development Plans
- ◆ Dissemination of CBs through the quarterly WASH forums (was mainly after Addis Ababa)
- ◆ County Commitments: sanitation conference (2017)
- ◆ Progress reported during 2017 county profiles review (County Benchmarking)
- ◆ Reported through GLAAS survey 2016/2017



Cont...

- ◆ Strong Government leadership and coordination
 - The government has put in place enabling environment (Policies sanitation sector) (Water, Act 2016 in place, still working on their policies)
 - 47 counties Progressively domesticating the National policies
 - Decentralized Governance-distinct functions for National and County governments

- ◆ Strengthening M & E in MOH (CLTs) and Water sector (WARIS)



Achievements

1. Government is working progressively towards a One Plan
2. Feedback of progress at National sanitation conferences
3. Counties aligning SDGs, Ngor, AMCOW , SWA and country indicators to counties..
4. Progressively strengthening online rural CLTs M & E
5. National SDG 6 steering committee in place for reporting
