# Difficulties are faced in developing and adhering to the agreed systems

- Transition phase of Federalism
- Political instability
- No clear role and responsibility
- Common understanding on definition
- Coordination among NPC and focal ministry
- Lack of baseline data
- NMIP data not suitable for JMP ( update issue)
- Catastrophic events (EQ, Flood)
