
5 new strategic priorities

- 2 Strengthening **government-led national processes**
- 3 Developing and using a **strong evidence base** to support good decision-making
- 4 Strengthening regional, national and local **human and institutional capacities**
- 5 Following-up and reviewing progress achieved in implementing sanitation, water and hygiene targets of the **SDGs**

Recent changes to governance



- Give greater role and responsibilities to countries
- Reflect global nature of SWA
- Reduce the number of constituencies and amend definitions
- Change the role of the Vice-Chair to an Executive Chair and expand the position's responsibilities
- Extend term of office for Steering Committee members – 3 years
- Clearer rules regarding observer status
- Clarify responsibilities and competencies of SC members
- Include individual and network CSOs as partners
